CLASS 1 Exercise Vehicle

Singles or pairs, open to all showing competitors, driving a non-traditional vehicle that could be driven every day for exercise and includes those with pneumatic tyres that are specifically designed for carriages. Lamps need not be carried. Showing class judged on the cleanliness and suitability of driver, vehicle, harness and horse - i.e. neat, tidy, workmanlike and safe.

Entry Fee: £10

Prizes: £15, £10, £5

CLASS 2 - Pleasure Driving

Pleasure Driving classes are for newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in Private Driving classes. Regular showing competitors are asked to respect this and entries for the Pleasure Driving class may not be accepted from those who enter our Private Driving classes.

To be judged:

- 15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness including those with pneumatic tyres that are specifically designed for carriages.
- 15% harness suitability, fit and cleanliness
- 70% driver and groom, horse/pony, way of going and suitability as a family pleasure animal.

Competitors may be given a brief series of tasks, e.g. driving through cones. Pneumatic tyres specifically designed for carriages are allowed. Lamps need not be carried.

CLASS 3 - Country Vehicle

Open to Singles, Pairs and Tandems driven to a country vehicle e.g. Governess Cart, Dog Cart, Norfolk Cart, Ralli Cart etc. suitably turned out for the country

CLASS 4 - Mountain & Moorland

Open to Singles, Pairs and Tandems driven to a suitable vehicle (commercial vehicles and hackney show wagons not permitted).

Entry Fee: £10

CLASS 5 - Hackney Type Horse or Pony

Open to Singles, Pairs and Tandems correctly and smartly harnessed to a sound, suitable and well maintained traditional vehicle suitable for a competent whip to drive on the road (commercial vehicles ,hackney show wagons and vehicles with pneumatic tyres are not permitted).

Entry Fee: £10

Prizes £15, £10, £5

Class 5 is a qualifier for the 2011 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Type-Section disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2011 Semi-Finals. Championship will immediately follow the Semi-Finals.

Type-Section a. Single hackney-type

CLASS 6 - Open Private Driving - Ponies 13.2 hands and under

Open to Singles, Pairs and Tandems correctly and smartly harnessed to a sound, suitable and well maintained traditional vehicle suitable for a competent whip to drive on the road (commercial vehicles ,hackney show wagons and vehicles with pneumatic tyres are not permitted).

CLASS 7 - Open Private Driving - Horses and ponies over 13.2 hands

CLASS 8 - Park Drive and Concours d'Elegance

The winner will be the turnout which, in the opinion of the Judge, presents the most pleasing picture, and normal judging criteria do not apply. Fancy dress or period costume is definitely barred. The class is judged from a distance and vehicles will NOT be closely inspected as in an ordinary show class.

Concours d'Elegance competitors must be in the collecting ring at **1230** for the Park Drive

Entry fee: £10

CLASS 9 - Light Trade Two Wheel Turnout

Open to singles and pairs. Vehicle should be suitable for a tradesman who delivers relatively light goods though no such goods should be carried whilst in the show ring. Vehicle may be painted according to the firm's colours with name of firm and business.

Entry Fee: £10

Prizes £15, £10, £5

Class 9 is a qualifier for the 2010 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Type-Sections disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2010 Semi-Finals. Championship will immediately follow the Semi-Finals.

Type-Sections: j. Two-wheel light trade

Open to singles and pairs. Vehicle should be suitable for a tradesman who delivers relatively light goods though no such goods should be carried whilst in the show ring. Vehicle may be painted according to the firm's colours with name of firm and business.

Light Trade Championship for the Wootton Oaks Trophy Classes 9 & 10 eligible

Show Rules

1. **Disclaimer of Liability** – So much as permitted by law the Show Organiser, the BHDTA, its officers, employees and representatives will not be liable to any person on entering or leaving the showground for any loss, damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items
 2. **Indemnity** All exhibitors, owners and competitors are advised to take out third party public liability insurance
 3. **Safety** All animals must be under control at all times whilst on the showground. Dogs must be kept on a lead.
 4. **Health and Safety** All exhibitors, owners and competitors must take all necessary measures with regards to health and safety.
 5. **Entries** The organiser is not liable for any errors in the schedule or for entries entered in the wrong class
 6. **Entry forms** All entries must be made on the official entry form and sent to arrive with the show secretary before the close of entries date.
 7. **Acceptance of Rules** All exhibitors on making an entry are deemed to have agreed to abide by these rules.
 8. **Rejection of entry** The organisers reserve the right to reject any entry without giving reason.
 9. **Classes** The organisers reserve the right to split or combine classes as appropriate to the entries received.
 10. **Judges.** The organisers reserve the right to change judges at their discretion
 11. **Judges** The judges decision is final and they shall not be obliged to explain their decision or enter into any correspondence regarding them
 12. Turnouts which in the opinion of the ring stewards, judge or other official are regarded as being a safety risk or potential hazard will be asked to leave the show ring and must do so immediately.
 13. Any competitor whose behaviour is in the opinion of the judge inappropriate must leave the show ring when asked to do so
 14. **Horses and ponies** All horses and ponies must be 4yrs old or over.
 15. **Young Drivers** – All grooms must not be less than 11 years old on the day of the show and appropriate for the type of vehicle. All drivers under the age of 18 must at all times when driving on the showground be accompanied by a competent and experienced groom age 18 or over. This regulation applies at all times and on all areas of the showground.
 16. **Protests and disputes** Any protest must be submitted in writing to the show organiser and when this is in relation to a class within 30 minutes of the class being judged with a deposit of £20.00 in cash, which may at the discretion of the show organisers, be forfeited if the dispute is disallowed. The show committee will review protests and their decision shall be final.
