The Championships are open to qualified competitors only.

Horses/ponies must be at least four years old.

All competitors must be Full, Young or Introductory members of BHDTA, with the exception of Novices who may also compete with BHDTA restricted Club or Associate membership.

All grooms on the marathon phase must have subscribed as Members or Marathon Grooms

All horses/ponies must be vaccinated in accordance with the prevailing BHDTA Rules.

Passport to include the record of vaccinations must be brought to the Championships.

SHOWGROUND DETAILS

The Stabling area will be open from **9.00a.m. Wednesday 7th September**. Permission MUST be obtained from BHDTA Office if you wish to arrive on Tuesday; there will be a charge of £10 per lorry for Tuesday night. Water and toilets provided. All caravans/horseboxes must be fitted with valid fire extinguishers.

Competitors are asked to report to the Stable Manager on arrival and to park where directed. Only one caravan per competitor. Please state on entry form if extra caravans required and add fee of £10 per caravan. Please note that paper bedding and electric fencing will not be permitted. Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all National events. A payment of £200 to cover the cost of restitution of the ground will be levied for non-compliance.

ATV's/MOTORCYCLES

The Crown Estate has agreed to allow competitors to use ATV's/motorcycles, **but only in a restricted area**. Details and map will be published on the stable manager's noticeboard, and **MUST BE ADHERED TO**.

It is a Crown Estate rule that HARD HATS MUST BE WORN **Non-compliance with these rules by competitors or their servants would render them liable to disqualification.** ATVs and motorbikes must only carry the number of people for which they are designed and must not be ridden by children.
