Stabling: Please report to the Stable Manager on arrival, all horseboxes will be obliged to park as directed. There is ample parking space for portable stabling but competitors arriving later should bear in mind that the remaining space could be undulating. Competitors must provide their own bedding for stables and clear up before departing. Please note, no electric fencing or paper bedding will be permitted.
